Short preamble

Europe, 2024!

2024 is the year of major challenges for our continent: the lack of resources finds Europe unprepared for contemporary economic challenges; the irrational, aggressive exploitation of resources, excessive consumption, energy waste, typical European conservatism, and in some places the disastrous management of the authorities, all of which lead to poor economic efficiency and serious changes to the landscape and the environment.

Now we are talking about **the concept of green buildings:** energy efficient, environmentally friendly, suitable for the 3Rs (reduce, reuse, recycle), dynamic, safe, comfortable; we want them all, the question is can we?! Could there be such a building, which would offer us all the conditions for a decent life and at the same time integrate perfectly into the surrounding environment? According to European statistics, 75% of existing buildings in Europe are energy inefficient; the revision of the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive, which is part of the "Get ready for 55" legislative package, will help to increase the energy efficiency of buildings in the EU. In October 2022, EU member states, meeting in the Council, agreed on a common position on the Commission's proposal to revise this directive. On 7 December 2023, the Council and the European Parliament reached a provisional political agreement on the proposal. "Get ready for 55" refers to the EU's target to reduce net greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030. The proposed package aims to align EU legislation with the 2030 target. EU countries are working on new legislation to to achieve this goal and for the EU to become climate neutral by 2050. Logically, as a result of what has been said so far, we are talking about green schools, where we not only learn, but also apply all these concepts, techniques, methods, aimed at transforming our institutions into models of green buildings, models for students, teachers, parents, community.

What is a Green School? The green school concept designates the profile of a school that creates a healthy environment and promotes learning, while saving resources, generating its own electricity and using technologies that reduce greenhouse gas emissions. green schools reduce fossil fuel energy and water consumption, collect waste separately and protect the environment. It also protects the health of students and teachers by ensuring a clean and healthy indoor environment, as well as providing programs and services for good nutrition and physical activity. We are not the only ones who have done this, we really want to think we are a drop from the ocean of lovers of nature, beauty, sustainability. This **European Green School Council** wants to be a Consortium of schools/institutions with concrete results in the implementation of school/educational projects in the field of green buildings. We believe that this alliance only benefits its members, because it will provide the opportunity for an effective exchange of experience, each institution will have the opportunity to share its own experience, but also the chance to learn from others, to accumulate those experiences of good practice and to pass them on.

Who are we?

"Tsani Ginchev" Primary School is located in the town of Lyaskovets, Bulgaria. The school organises national events in the field of sports and applied arts aimed at integrating the entire school community - parents, children and school teams. At local level, the school organises events related to the historical and cultural heritageof the homeland. The school actively interacts with the parents in several main directions: sports holidays; school quizzes; meetings of the Club "Inclusive Parent", aimed at increasing parenting capacity and strengthening the family-school relationship.

"Private Filiz High School" ("Filiz") is an innovative Turkish School in the city of Edirne which educates children from preschool to high school ages. Its mission is to educate the pupils of 21st century by teaching the skills of the progressive new era spirit and keeping the roots of the traditional values. The professional team is composed of high level pedagogical experts with rich experience in education within the national and foreign educational systems. The school environment is positive and creative and fosters the development of skills and competences associated with self-confidence, problem solving, entrepreneurship, analytical thinking, digital literacy, teamworking, emotional intelligence, leadership, perception of self-efficacy. The principles of education lay on the individual approach to identify and respond to the individual needs and to provide the appropriate support and program, enabling all students to achieve their full potential to be active and complete global citizens of 21st century. The philosophy, educational values and the activities in the primary education are focused in providing happy ecosystem for happy kids without aggression, discrimination, disrespect.

Pakruojis "Zemyna" progymnasium is located in the center of Pakruojis. School was oppened on the 1st of September 1982. It's a public school and the school children are with different abilities. We have 22 classes, including 475 children at all. There are 41 teacher, 11 student support workers and 3 administrative employee at school. There is a library, 3 classrooms of ICT, classrooms of chemistry and physics, technology workshop classroom too. We pay a big attention for information technology at school. Our children from 1st to 4th grades take part in a state project "ICT in primary education". We have non-formal activity of robot, six classroom has an interactive board. All our teachers and children have improved their ICT skills on this school year. Our school started useing Office 365 system, all the lessons are taken in Teams platform. We use Scratch, Code, Imagine Logo in the lesson. Primary education uses Bee Bot too. Our children take part in robot competitions and already won some of these competitions. Our teachers who are taking part in the project are responsible and have already been taking part in some of state project.

Mine Vaganti NGO is a non-profit organisation established in Sardinia in 2009, whose services encompass Education and Training, Project Design and Development, Thematic Research, International Mobility, and Consultancy - in Youth, Adults, Education and Sport sectors. MVNGO has 3 offices in Sassari, Olbia and Tempio Pausania impacting the North of Sardinia and reaching out with its operational branches to many other regions in Italy, around Europe and beyond. The members of MVNGO operate in dedicated teams to create, develop and implement international projects in research, innovation or exchange of good practices sometime















reaching the target via seminars and/ or training courses. Among the MVNGO working-teams, there are trainers/facilitators (Salto accredited) that enjoy a vast experience and willing to be involved for the implementation of proposed projects. The organisation is composed of 10 full-time staff meanmbers, 15 coworkers employed on a temporary basis under different mobility programmes, and a pool of 70 externals contracted on a yearly / or project basis.

What are we doing here? We sign the constitution of the EGSC, agree on the Operating Regulations, propose an Action Plan for the next year, establish a calendar of the proposed activities, promote this Consortium and try to attract other members from the school/educational community of Europe. 






















































First Summit of EGSC - day 3
